ICATTI 2026 Conference Proceedings

Welcome to ICATTI 2026. This document collects the formatting, submission, and review rules for papers that will appear in the conference proceedings. Authors are expected to read it in full before preparing their manuscript. The accompanying LaTeX and Word templates apply most of these rules automatically.

1. Submission Tracks

High-Speed Rail	Alignment, dynamics, signalling, electrification, station and corridor planning.
Smart Infrastructure	Digital twins, IoT-based monitoring, BIM, structural health and AI-assisted operations.
Sustainable Mobility	Low-carbon transport, multimodal integration, transport policy and equity.
Resilient Transport Systems	Climate adaptation, multi-hazard risk, asset management, post-disaster recovery.

2. Length and File Format

2.1 Paper categories

Full papers present original research with substantive results — 8–12 pages including figures, tables, and references. **Short papers** describe focused contributions, case studies, or work-in-progress — 4–6 pages.

2.2 File format

Submit a single PDF file (max 15 MB) using the conference submission system. The source files (.tex or .docx, plus figures and any data appendices) will be requested after acceptance.

3. Formatting Summary

Page size	A4 (210 × 297 mm), single-column layout
Margins	Top/Bottom 2.5 cm • Left/Right 2.3 cm
Body font	Times / Times New Roman, 10 pt, line spacing 1.15
Section headings	Bold, 13 pt (1st level) / 11 pt (2nd level)
Figures	Vector (PDF/EPS) preferred; raster ≥ 300 dpi
Tables	Use the booktabs style — no vertical rules



Equations	Numbered only if referenced in the text
Reference style	Numerical, sorted and compressed
Language	English (UK or US — be consistent)

Important: the supplied LaTeX class (*icatti2026.cls*) and Word template apply every rule in this table automatically. Do not override margins, fonts, or section styles.

4. Manuscript Structure

- **Title.** ≤ 15 words; informative; avoid abbreviations.
- **Authors and affiliations.** Full given name and family name. Mark the corresponding author with ✳.
- **Abstract.** 150–250 words; no citations, no equations, no undefined acronyms.
- **Keywords.** 5–7 keywords separated by semicolons.
- **Body.** Introduction → Related Work → Methodology → Results → Discussion → Conclusion.
- **Acknowledgements.** Funding, data, and tool acknowledgements.
- **Author contributions.** Use a CRediT-style statement.
- **References.** All references must be cited in the text.
- **Appendices (optional).** Numbered A, B, C — placed after the references.

5. Figures, Tables, and Equations

All figures, tables, and equations must be numbered consecutively and referenced from the text (e.g. *see Fig. 2, Eq. (3)*). Captions go *below* figures and *above* tables.

Figures should be legible when printed at A4 size in greyscale. Avoid red/green-only colour coding for accessibility. Maps must include a scale bar and a north arrow.

6. Ethics, Originality, and AI Use

By submitting, authors confirm that the work is original, has not been published elsewhere, and is not under concurrent review. Plagiarism and duplicate publication are grounds for desk rejection. Data from human subjects must be collected under appropriate ethics approval.

Use of generative AI tools to draft or polish a manuscript must be disclosed in the Acknowledgements section, including the tool name, version, and the sections affected. AI tools cannot be listed as authors.

7. Review Process

Manuscripts undergo **double-blind peer review** by at least two members of the technical programme committee. During review, remove author names, affiliations, and self-identifying references. The Word and LaTeX templates include an “anonymous mode” comment block.
